Section VI: Technical Specifications

Standard Specifications

1.1 Standard Specifications

The “*Standard Specifications (Civil Works)*” issued by the Project Management Unit, RUIDP, set out the specifications that shall be followed for construction of general civil works under the RUIDP. Specifications for additional specialized items of civil works, and/or for mechanical and electrical works, shall be as set out in Part B, Particular Specifications, of this Section.

The priced publications of RUIDP on “Standard Specifications of Civil Works” and “Quality Assurance and Quality Control (QAQC)” from the office of the Project Director, RUIDP at Jaipur will form the part of the bid document.

In the event of any discrepancy between the provisions of the Standard Specifications and the Particular Specifications, then the provisions of the Particular Specifications will prevail.

The contractor shall also submit weekly/daily micro-plan for all the months separately as well, which shall be up-dated every month to have an effective monitoring tool.

6.0 IDENTIFYING DEFECTS:

The calibration of the laboratory equipment & instrument shall be properly maintained & calibrated throughout the period of the contract by the Contractor at his own expense. *The items are to be specifically mentioned.* The contractor shall notify the Employer's Representative in sufficient advance prior to conducting any tests for materials & work. The Employer's Representative will also inspect the laboratory if deemed necessary and the Contractor shall provide adequate facilities to the Employer's Representatives for his independent verification of the accuracy & adequacy of the facilities.
