

Widening of Existing ROB near Bhagat Singh Circle at Alwar

The Jai Marg (SH-15) is one of the major link to Alwar town. It intersects the level crossing no. 115A on Alwar Mathura broad gauge Railway line. A 2 lane ROB was constructed over the Railway line in year 1984. As traffic over existing 2 lane ROB reached to 17642 PCU and As per IRC SP 73 capacity of 2 lane road is 15000 PCU per day. Due to considerable increase in traffic the capacity of existing 2 lane ROB was exhausted and accordingly proposal was framed to construct additional 2 lane RoB parallel to existing ROB. The proposal was approved in City Level Committee meeting and finally the proposal was sanctioned to widen the existing 2 lane to to 4 lane ROB on Jai Marg at Alwar an amounting to Rs Rs 2225.72 lacs with stipulated date of commencement & completion 12.09.2012 & 11.06.2014 respectively. The following is the key outcomes from the Subproject:
